Episodic anthology; 12 episodes; animated surrealist fantasy



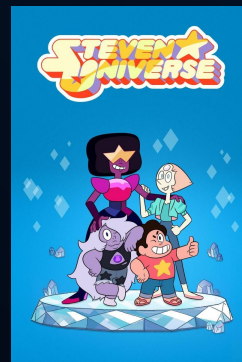
## AUDIENCE

- ★ INFJ-T



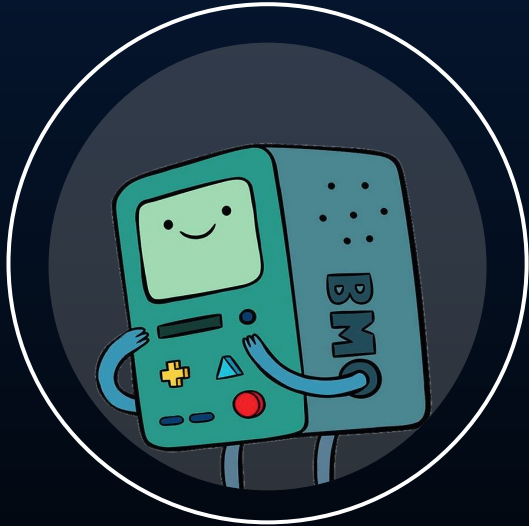


# BIXBY

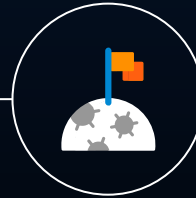
## ESTABLISHING

est. relationship



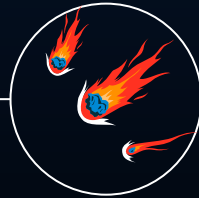
## CROSSING THRESHOLD

go to village



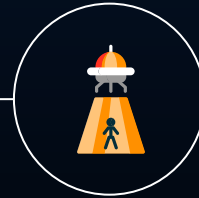
## INCITING
